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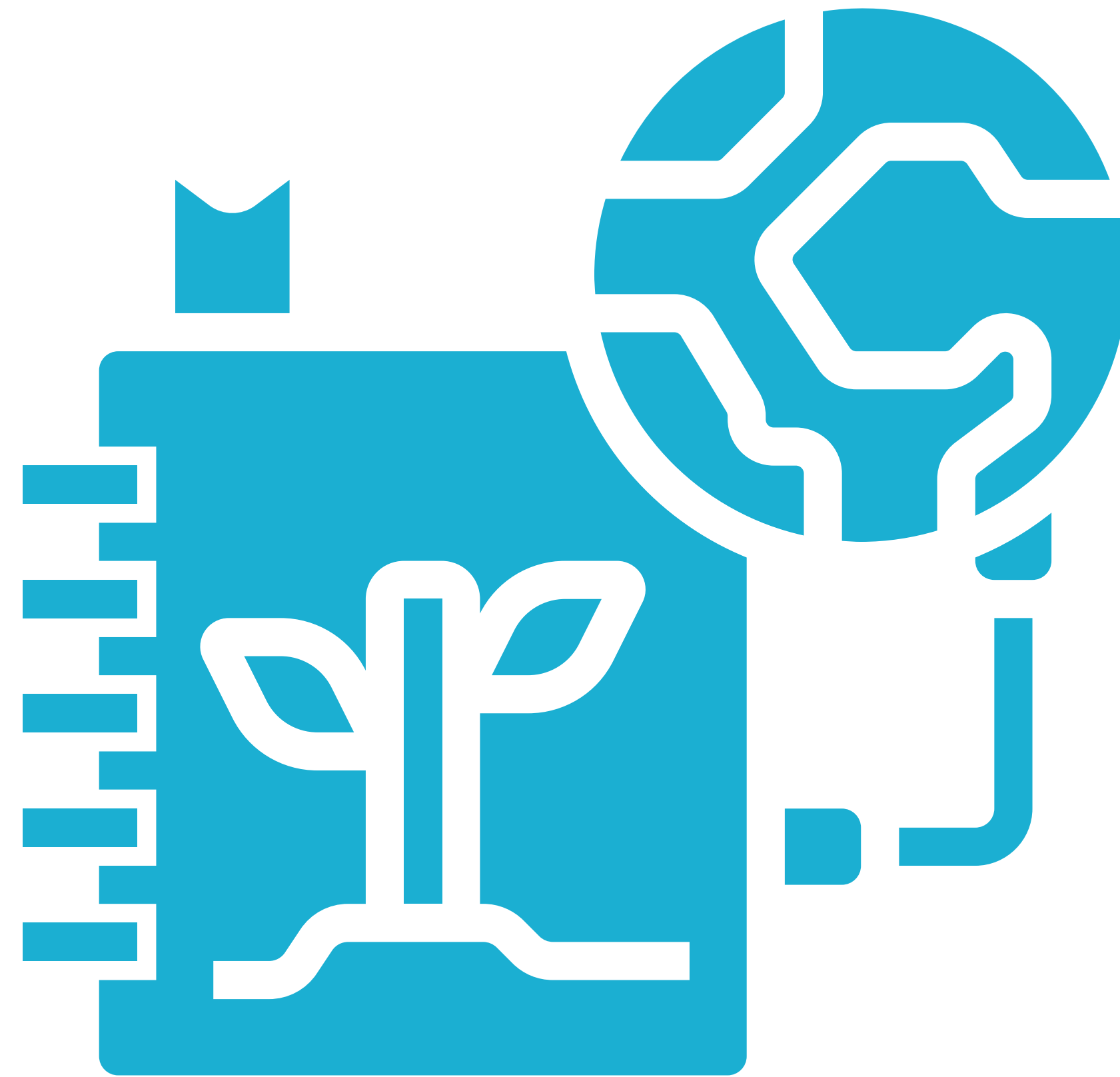

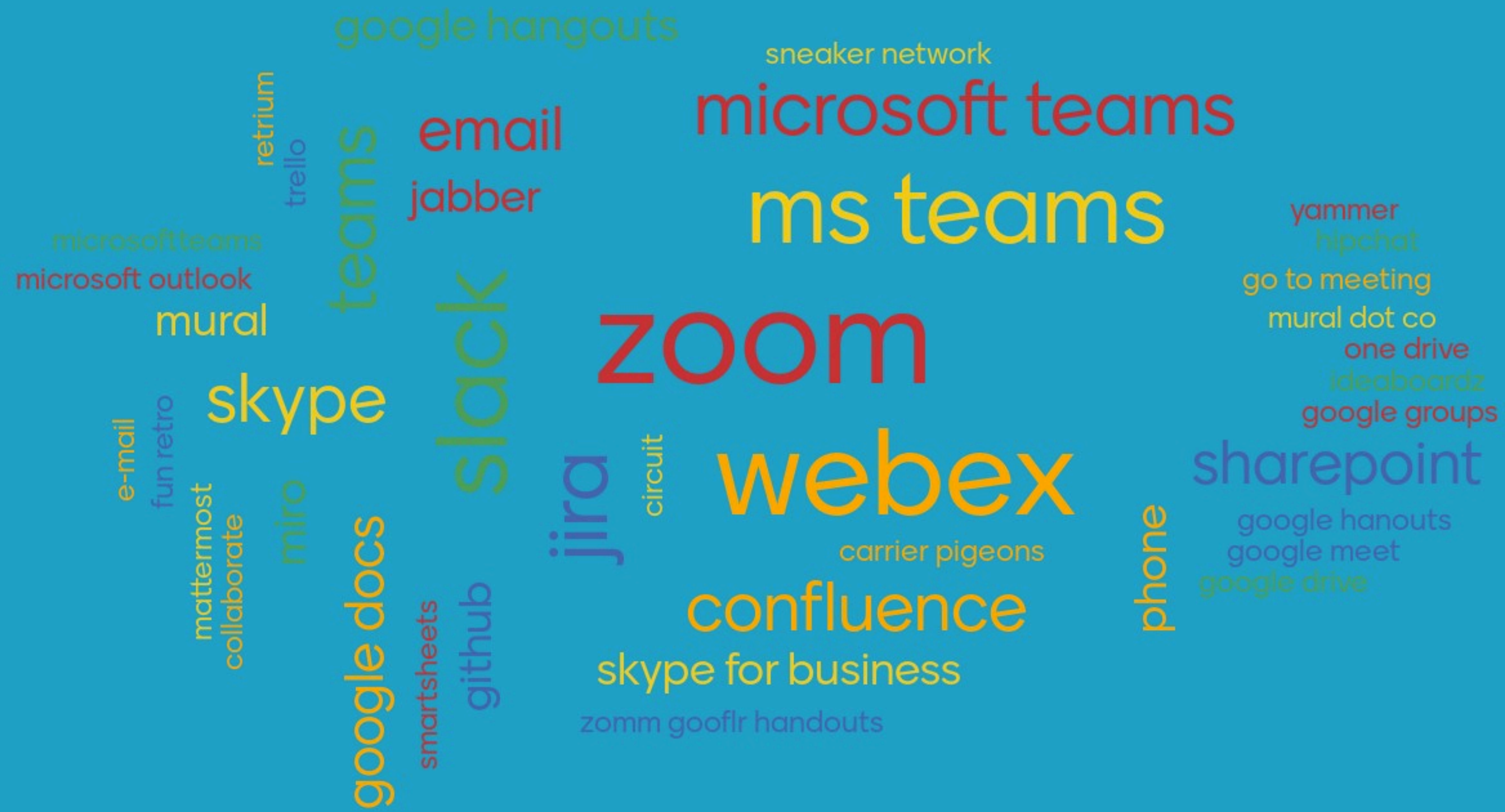

Why Is Tool Selection Important?

When we are not physically colocated:

- There are barriers to talking more frequently and people get excluded
- Non-verbal communication may be lost
- It's hard to keep everyone updated
- Learning new tools can be difficult
- Getting support/help can be more difficult
- Managing time is harder

What problems are you seeing that working remotely is causing, or making worse?



Pull vs Push Communication

Pull communication: Initiated by consumer to get the latest content from content producers

- Good for dashboards, less time-sensitive information
- Examples: Email, website/wiki pages, story boards

Push communication: Initiated by the content producer to alert consumers

- Good for requests for help, coordinating work, more time-sensitive information
- Examples: Chat applications, alerting systems, phone

Non Collaborative Tools

TL;DR: Excel is not a collaborative tool

Anything involving file sharing, passing files back and forth, files in a shared folder, is prone to issues with

- People undoing others' work, or adding their updates to an older version
- Confusion over what the latest version is
- People missing from the distribution list
- Lack of notifications of updates

Truly Collaborative Tools

Collaborative tools [ideally] provide:

- One one true shared source of truth
- Always accessible to all involved
- Versioning, with user attribution
- Simultaneous editing
- Commenting
- Notifications of updates to all who wish

Other Considerations

- Consider licensing
- Consider privacy, and data exposure (Free isn't always free)
- Consider learning curves
- Using too many tools can lead to confusion; sometimes it's better to use something known instead of a better tool
- Consider accessibility and diversity
- Consider integrations with other tools

Tools That Support Collaboration

- **Wikis** (Confluence, etc) usually offer all of the features of the previous slide. There are also many cloud-based and on-prem free options
- **Google Docs** allows simultaneous editing (beware of licensing and privacy though)
- **Chat tools** that support different rooms/channels/topics can offer a balance of instant communication to the right people while keeping the signal/noise ration manageable
- All-in-one remote **project tools** ([Basecamp](#), etc)
- **Lean Coffee** to include new topics and concerns
